## Castellani

Since 1903 the Castellani family has been exporting its estate wines from Tuscany. The company has changed and evolved over the decades, but throughout the years the constant philosophy of their work has remained the same: ?The quality of the wine begins in the vineyard?. Over the last 10 years they have invested heavily in research and new technologies to ensure that their passion for their wines continues to result in achieving the high quality that they strive for. The Castellani family controls over 1000 hectares of landed estates situated in the territories of Chianti, Chianti Classico and Maremma; around 210 hectares of their own properties are planted to specialised vineyards where the vines are pruned and tended in ways that assure production of grapes of the finest quality, mainly noble Tuscan varietals such as Sangiovese and Sangiovese Grosso. A winery is located in each vineyard?s estate so that the grapes can be immediately pressed, vinified and refined in the best traditional way. Today they have also branched out of Tuscany to many other great wine growing regions in Italy, taking with them their philiosophy of quality.
